Dear Praying Friends,

Since Al is still in Israel, he's asked me to fill in for the prayer letter writing this month.

I have been calling pastors to schedule Al's calendar for over 26 years. Often he is asked if any of the pastors where he preaches have a problem with Jewish ministry. I must say that if these pastors have a problem, I am the first one to interact with them. I have had many conversations with pastors who feel that God is finished with the Jews and the Gospel is no longer for them. They enjoy claiming all the good promises God gave to Israel, but ignore the stern warnings God gave His people should they decide to disobey His commands. I've been reading Jeremiah and Ezekiel the past few weeks. This morning I read Ezekiel 35 & 36. God's words given to Ezekiel are not the warm fuzzies that most modernday Replacement Theologians embrace. God is very clear in Ezekiel 36: 17-23 when He laid out the sin of the Hebrew nation and what He would do to them because of their rebellion. He is not done with Israel and continues to work in the lives of His people, the Jews.

Our tract ministry is one of many ways to bring the Gospel to the Jewish people. As of right now over 1900+ folks have helped us send 152,000 tracts to Jewish people in our area. God's Word is at work. Another way our ministry endeavors to spread the Gospel is by Al sharing his passion through his preaching in churches. There is no more effective witness than a friend who has a burden to reach the Jewish people in their circle.

By the end of this week, the Israel tour group will be back home. They will be tired from running where Jesus walked, and overwhelmed with the visual impressions they experienced while they were there. From this point forward, they will have new eyes when they read God's Word. When they read about Jesus walking from the Galilee to Jerusalem, they now know how far away that is and what the terrain looks like. The Garden of Gethsemane will pop when they read about Jesus taking time to go there and pray. Indeed, this trip is a life changer. The 2023 trip dates are April 24 through May 4. We already have 10 folks who've paid their deposit.

Michele and I remain grateful for your continued faithful prayer and financial support. Apart from you our ministry could not be possible. Please never forget that it is by your mercy they shall obtain mercy! Romans 11:30-31.
