Michele had a follow up with her surgeon and he is very pleased with her progress! She showed me last night that she can bend her arm to almost touch her chin. She certainly has come a long way but still has more to go. Her surgeon wants her to continue physical therapy twice a week for the next 4-6 weeks. We appreciate your prayers for her and know we can count on your continued prayer for her full recovery.

We continue to send out my tract to Jewish families in Houston. Thanks to so many volunteers in the churches we have now mailed this tract to 143,000 Jewish families. Please pray that the people receiving it will respond and allow us to build a relationship enabling us to build a witness.

There are times I go into some remote areas of the country which are out of the mainstream of Judaism. Sometimes I am convinced I am the only Jewish person they had ever seen but I quickly find this is far from the case. I was in a church in Alaska in August when a lady came to me following the service. She told me she had a family member who married a Jewish person and she was always in a quandary as to how to speak to them. She told me it was always a difficult thing for her, but now with the things she learned from me, she feels very confident in approaching her family members. She told me that if I came all the way to Alaska for no one else, she knows I came for her! This is why I always say that our Mission Statement has two equal parts. First, to take the gospel to Jewish people directly, and second, to preach in churches transferring my burden to their hearts and giving them tools enabling them to be a more effective witness. One is no more or less important than the other!
