Sitting here listening to the fireworks going off in our neighborhood, I realize another year is behind us and we are facing a new year full of hope and promise. As I contemplate the New Year and what lies ahead, I cannot help but reflect on 2018 -- and all God has accomplished in and through us over the past 12 months. My travels took me to over 100 churches in the US, as well as opportunities in Japan, Amsterdam and Italy, with 164,000 miles logged. We saw the Lord touch the hearts of more than 3,700 souls who made decisions in 2018.

One of the highlights of the year was going to Japan where I preached in several churches, brought a series of 9 lectures at the Japan Baptist Bible College and was privileged to be one of the Commencement speakers for their graduation. The Lectures covered 3 main areas: The Concept of Ritual in Judaism, The Concept of Sacred in Judaism and The Concept of Worship in Judaism. These were so well received that we are looking for opportunities to bring this lecture series to Bible Colleges here in the States.

It might seem that all I do is travel and preach, however, our local outreach here in the Metroplex has taken off. We have now mailed 90,000 households in the Dallas/Fort Worth area our "What Will Messiah Look Like" tract. Along with this comes the follow up for those who respond. The Tract provides us an opening into the lives of the Jewish people who receive it and respond to us. It is merely the beginning of this effort. We are blessed to have an ever-growing number of volunteers who make this effort possible. We have some 1,200 people all across the country addressing envelopes, providing postage and then stuffing the envelopes making them ready for us to mail.

Our ministry has a two-fold Mission Statement. First, to bring the gospel to Jewish people; and secondly, and equally important, to educate the churches about their need to do the same. As we embark on our 23rd year in Jewish ministry we are excited to reflect on how the Lord continues to bless us as we remain faithful to our stated purpose!
