Sending Church: Hallmark Baptist Church, Fort Worth, Texas Mike Haley Pastor Dear Praying Friends:

February has been a very exciting month! It began by taking me to the Pacific Northwest, central Florida, West Texas and the Carolinas. Along the way I also spoke in a Bible College class on the Pentateuch, held my monthly Bible study and managed to celebrate our daughter's 25th birthday. What a full month!

I was in Seattle on Super Bowl
Sunday, a "Super" Sunday! There were 6
souls who came to faith that morning,
which is exciting enough in and of itself.
However, the Associate Pastor gave me the
back story on one who got saved that
morning and it made it even more thrilling.
I was told of a young autistic boy who came
regularly but his father very seldom would.
On this particular morning he had plead
with his father to come to church with him
and just to satisfy his son he agreed to
come and wound up getting saved that
morning!

Later in the month I had the joy of preaching in a small oil field town in West Texas. In the Fall of 1983 the Lord took us out to West Texas and then on to SE New Mexico. I always thought God had a strange sense of humor dragging me out of Detroit all the way out to West Texas. I'd ask "What...There were no graves in Detroit? You had to drag me out here to kill me?" I had no way of knowing that I had a Divine appointment to keep. I met an old preacher out there who loved the Jewish people...at that stage of my life, I didn't...he did! He came up to me at a fellowship meeting in Lubbock and said "Hebrew, I want you to be in my Mission Conference. I want you to represent the Jews!" I asked what I would do and he told me I'd come up with something and walked off. That's when I

first put together and preached my testimony message and my Christ in the Passover. That was March, 1984...31 years ago...and I've been doing these ever since.

The Lord moved us to Chicago in 1991 and that Pastor retired and moved to Amarillo. While he and I stayed connected I lost touch with the church in Denver City, TX. This month I had the joy of re-connecting with this church and preached there this month for the first in 25 years. It was a little bit of a home coming for me and a very special time! If not for that pastor and this church I would probably not have overcome what I term my Anti-Semitic Jewish period. My life and ministry had been radically changed because of meeting this old preacher who loved the Jewish people, took me under his wing and lovingly transferred the burden of his heart to mine. I would call him and share this experience with him but he has already gone to Heaven...but I think he knows!

We closed registration for this year's Israel tour. I have a very good group joining me next month for this very special time. We have set the dates for next year for May 9-19, 2016. Please consider joining us! I know it will be a life changing event!
