In February we found ourselves, along with much of Texas, engulfed in what has been termed an Arctic Blast. Temperatures plummeted to those not seen in Fort Worth for 100 years. We typically have an ice storm at least once each winter, but these only last a day and then the sun comes out the next day and all is good. This storm was actually 3 storms in a row each one worse than the previous one. We were doing everything to keep warm but we could not escape the damage from this extreme cold weather. We have a two story house which has a separate HVAC system for each floor. The second floor furnace quit which caused our pipes to freeze and then burst. Thankfully a neighbor came and dealt with the immediate plumbing issue but the water damage is quite extensive. Because an extensive area was impacted, we are on a long waiting list for repairs. Our Homeowners policy should cover most, if not all the damage. We already had one field adjuster come out who had no clue about anything, making a bad situation worse. I had a long discussion with our agent as well as the adjuster assigned to our claim and both have assured me that we have no cause for concern. We are expecting a new field adjuster to come next week and have been assured this is a mere formality to confirm the damage and move forward with satisfying our claim. Please pray this all goes smoothly and we can move forward with restoring our home.

We have now mailed my tract, What Will Messiah Look Like to every Jewish family throughout the Dallas/Ft. Worth Metroplex! We have mailed this tract to 137,000 Jewish homes. If you consider 4 to a household that means we have identified 548,000 Jewish people in the Metroplex. That is a huge number especially considering that when we began this project my research told me there were but 60,000 Jewish people in the Metroplex. This also reveals that not only is the Jewish community much larger than any knew, but that they are going unnoticed and neglected where the Gospel is concerned. Please pray that these Jewish families read and respond to this tract. Just sending the tract is not the end but the beginning. As they respond then the work actually begins. As such we would encourage and welcome your prayers for the follow up to all of the responses we receive.

I am still hopeful that Israel will soon reopen to tourism. I have not planned another tour as yet. I am waiting until I am sure we will actually be able to make the trip. Once Israel does reopen, I will plan the next tour and you will be able to find the Tour Info on our website.
