Michele and I now begin our 22nd year as Jewish missionaries. God continues to provide countless opportunities to extend our ministry of reaching Jewish people with the gospel all across the country. I am finding an awaking to the need of the church including the Jewish community in their area in their missionary and evangelistic outreach at every church I preach. One such example is a lady in a church here in Fort Worth who became burdened about personally witnessing to Jewish people she comes in contact with. She requested some of the tracts I had written and then took them to the Israelis who work the Dead Sea products kiosk in the Mall. She used the tract to open a conversation with the young Israeli man, gave it to him and then later watched him read the tract in the Food Court. This is more and more typical of the type of stories people in the churches are relating to me about, telling me that before I came to speak in their church they never gave a second thought to witnessing to Jewish people. Now they are seeking out those opportunities.

We have now mailed 73,000 tracts to Jewish people here in the Metroplex. We continue to see a mix of responses to this effort. This month we received a somewhat angry reaction from a Jewish person telling me that our attempt to convert Jewish people is "shameful." I have come to find that the harsher the reaction, the more indication that the message is hitting home. We have learned to pray more for those who lash out like this as they seem to be wrestling against the work the Holy Spirit is doing in their heart. To the opposite end of this spectrum, we also received a response from a lady telling us she was a believer and asked us to send her several tracts that she may use with her Jewish friends. Both responses are very encouraging! Both indicate that the Lord is using this effort in the hearts of those who are receiving the tract!

I have dates for our Annual Israel Tour for 2019. Please mark these dates and plan to join us next year! Since Passover is later next year we had to push the dates a bit later in order to avoid the influx of Jewish pilgrims flooding into Israel for the Holy days as well as the cost going up significantly. That said, our dates are set for May 13-23, 2019. I am doing some things for 2019 which should bring the cost down while maintaining the same level of touring we have always enjoyed. Please pray that I will be able to accomplish this and thus make the tour pricing less prohibitive. We are working to add the Tour Page to our Website and hope to have it up and running within the next couple of weeks. Once up, you will be able to log onto our website, click on the tour page and find more information on the tour, as well as a secure Registration Page enabling you to reserve your seats.
