We are certainly happy to see 2020 behind us. Normally I preach in some 100 churches a year all across the country. However, from the middle of March to the middle of May most of the churches scheduled were forced to cancel and I had a few live stream services during that time. Still, in spite of these obstacles, the Lord prevailed and I ended the year preaching in 86 churches and saw God do wonderful things time and time again. While 2020 undoubtedly was a very challenging year it was also a year to witness the reality of God's declaration in Ps 46:10-"Be still, and know that I am God." Also Job 37:14-"Hearken unto this O Job: Stand still and consider the wonderous works of God." Amid all the turmoil and uncertainty which 2020 had delivered, we were forced to a place where we had to stand still! As we did, we had little time to fret or complain. As we stood still we began to know and experience God in ways we had long forgotten. We had a wonderful opportunity to consider His wonderous works He performed for our ministry as well as for Michele and I personally. We saw God pick us up, carry us, provide for us and bless our ministry in marvelous ways! We cannot be sure that 2021 will be any different than 2020 but we can be certain that our God will continue to be our God and as we pause and stand still, we will continue to witness Him reveal Himself in ways we had not yet considered!

Our outreach in 2020 continued as we kept mailing our tract to Jewish families here in the Dallas/Ft. Worth Metroplex. Many who had volunteered in the past found themselves with nothing to do. They called Michele and requested another list of names and addresses saying that while they couldn't leave the house, they had plenty of time to address envelopes. Consequently, we were able to mail our tract to 2,000 Jewish families each month. We have now mailed our tract to 136,000 Jewish homes. This represents well over 500,000 Jewish people right here in the Metroplex. We are now to the letters Z! When we mail these out, we will have mailed my tract to every Jewish family in the Metroplex. Please be praying that they will read and respond as then the real work begins! We will now be focusing on Houston, as there is a large Jewish population there.
