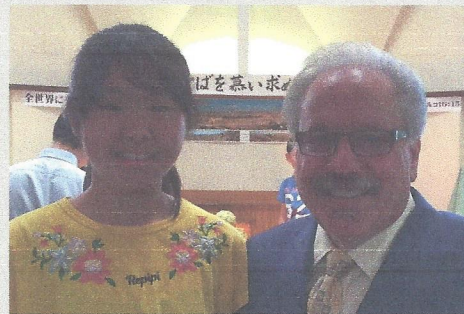

July 1 marked 5 years since we launched Ahavath Messiah Ministries. Michele and I are constantly amazed at how God has used this ministry over the past 5 years. The Lord has opened doors of ministry that had otherwise been closed to us prior to launching Ahavath. I continue to preach in 100 churches a year. We see more than 3,800 decisions a year at these church meetings and have mailed my tract What Will Messiah Look Like to 83,000 Jewish people in the Metroplex.



While in Japan I was privileged to preach in 3 churches. The last church was in the mountains. I preached my testimony message through the use of an interpreter. Because the interpretation more than doubles the length of the message, I had to cut this message down to just 18 minutes but the interpretation of the message took 45 minutes. Even with this, the truth of the message apparently came through as a 15 year-old teenage girl trusted Jesus as her Savior at the close of the service. I was later told that in the first church I preached in on this trip there were several who had responded as well. I am amazed at how the story of a Jewish boy in Detroit coming to faith resonates in the heart of a Japanese teenage girl in Japan.
