### Dear Praying Friends,

Back in February when we had the freeze that gripped the entire state of Texas, Michele slipped and fell on the ice on our driveway. She came down squarely on her elbow. She went to our doctor who believed that since she was able to move it fairly well that she had merely bruised a bone and felt she would be fine. When it did not improve, she went back and he sent her for an X-Ray. From the X-Ray he was convinced she had not only broken it but had chipped off a piece of the bone. He referred her to an elbow specialist. He sent her for an MRI which showed him where the chipped piece is and Michele is scheduled to have surgery to remove it with a minimally invasive, arthroscopic procedure at the end of July. Please keep her in your prayers. Michele has pain and her movement is restricted, along with some swelling, but the specialist says the bone is healing and expects her to have no residual effects once he removes the bone chip.

Our tract outreach continues to move forward. We are now sending these to Jewish families in Houston where there is a large Jewish community. We have mailed our tract to 138,000 Jewish families here in the Metroplex and now to 8,000 Jewish families in the Houston area. We have been doing this outreach for almost 8 years and we just received notice from the Post Office that our response card is too small to be processed through their equipment. As you might figure, we had just received a new order of 5,000 tracts and response cards from the printer. So, they couldn't have told us before we spent that money? Oh well, we will just need to enlarge the size of the card, but then it won't fit well in the envelope with the tract without folding it. Guess we will just have to fold them from now on or risk having the Post Office refuse to send them through the mail process.

It is beginning to look like I will be able to begin taking tours to Israel again very soon. Israel is planning to re-open to tourism and I am working now with EL AL Airlines to secure seats for my group which has been waiting patiently since 2019. Please pray the airline will work it out and accommodate my group as they are being flooded with tour groups like mine who are anxious to go! Michele and I remain grateful for your faithful prayer and financial support. Apart from you our ministry could not be possible. Please always remember, it is by your mercy that they shall obtain mercy! Romans 11:30-31.
