The coronavirus is certainly making ministry more creative than ever. I have done some live stream services, including a Christ in the Passover last night. Unfortunately, most of our church meetings canceled for the month of April and I have had to push our Israel Tour off to January. Along with the strain on ministry and the loss of income, my being stuck around the house may be more than Michele will be able to bear. I am normally on the road some 200 nights a year. My calculations show that in the past 25 years I have been home just 9 years. Suddenly I tend to be under foot...a lot!

Our Tract Outreach continues to be very exciting. We have now mailed our tract to 121,000 Jewish homes. When you stop and consider how many are in each home this reveals a much larger Jewish community here in the Metroplex than any realized! The problem is that they are going unnoticed and neglected where the Gospel is concerned. When we receive the response cards from those who receive the tract, we begin to develop a more personal rapport with each individual. This often starts with email discussions which then moves to phone conversations and ultimately to meeting one on one. All of this begins with the tract being mailed out. This only happens because of the many in the churches I preach in who volunteer to address envelopes and provide the postage for each envelope coupled with the army of those in our home church who stuff those envelopes so we can mail them. We are always amazed at how many are so very anxious to participate in this outreach, proving to me that most want to reach Jewish people and this gives them that opportunity!

As I mentioned, our Israel Tour, which was set to depart later this month has now been pushed to January. This, however, will not affect our 2021 tour dates which are set for May, 2021. We are already taking deposits for that tour. You will find the information on our website www.ahavathmessiah.com. We are praying with you that everyone will stay safe and healthy and that we will very soon be relieved from house arrest and be able to return to our normal routines. We are also praying that our churches will remain strong through this difficult time and will soon be rejoicing as we gather once again to lift our hearts together in worship of our Lord and Savior!
