Dear Praying Friends,

With the coronavirus restrictions still preventing many churches in several states from holding in person church services, we continue to experience an inordinate number of canceled meetings. I had only one week which did not cancel in May but what a wonderful week that turned out to be! I preached in 5 churches in Montana and every one was a wonderful blessing! This was my first time to preach in Montana so I was very excited about this trip. The Lord did great things in each meeting and this is the beginning of what I expect to be a long relationship with these churches.

We are staying busy with ministry during this down time and continue to utilize a number of outreach ministries which I do not get a lot of opportunity to speak about, but are vital ministries. I do a 5-10 minute Vlog which is uploaded once a week to our Facebook page. These Vlogs, especially during this shutdown, are reaching out further than ever before and more people than ever before. There is a link to these on our website, so wherever our website and Facebook are accessible we are able to have an impact. We have also uploaded a 22-minute version of my testimony entitled My Journey To Messiah to YouTube. This is an interview format where I respond to questions posed to me by Michele who is off camera. Both of these are intended as an added layer of ministry and have been showing an increasing number of viewers and responses.

Then there is our ongoing Tract outreach. This has always been dependent on people in the churches I preach in volunteering to address the envelopes and provide the postage. So many of our volunteers have stepped up during this time when I'm not able to be in churches. Many have contacted us wanting to use their down time to address more envelopes. As a result, since March we have been able to mail out 2,000 tracts each month bringing us to a grand total of 126,000 tracts sent to Jewish homes here in the Metroplex. This is an exciting accomplishment, but what excites me more than anything are the volunteers who tell us that they pray for each and every family which will receive the tract. I just have to believe that having believers all across the country praying for specific Jewish people here in the Metroplex must be a good thing!

We still have plans for our annual Israel Tour for 2021. The dates are set for May 24-June 3, 2021. You will find all the info on our website at www.ahavathmessiah.com. It is not too early to make your deposit as there are only so many seats available.
