Dear Praying Friends,

We have been in Jewish ministry for 24 years. Our ministry has a two-pronged mission statement. The first being our direct outreach to Jewish people here in the Dallas Ft. Worth Metroplex and the second being our inreach into the churches across the country. Every bit as important as our work in the Jewish community is impacting the hearts of Pastors and believers for a people group so often left out and neglected in our missionary and evangelistic outreach. Preaching in churches gives me the opportunity to transfer the burden of my heart to their hearts as well as give them tools to use in their witness to Jewish people. Understanding this you should appreciate how difficult it was for me when the first time I found myself forced to cancel a preaching trip. I came home from one such trip in early October with the worst sinus infection I had come down with in a very long time. I wound up in bed for 2 weeks, only getting out of bed to go lay on the sofa, OY! In spite of this, once recovered I managed a very full preaching schedule which took me to Indiana, Minnesota, Wisconsin and Washington State. I was privileged to return to some churches as well as preach for the first time in several others. Despite facing obstacles such as Covid and unexpected snow storms we saw good crowds and wonderful receptiveness to our message and ministry!

Michele has found a solution to our problem we had harvesting addresses for our tract outreach. It will require a little more effort for those who volunteer to address the envelopes but nothing too difficult. We are thankful to be able to resume this outreach and keep it moving forward! We have mailed our tract to 134,000 Jewish homes. Considering how many in each home, this suggests we have reached out to more than 500,000 Jewish people with this tract and we are still in the letter "S"!

Please keep some health issues in your prayers. I will be having a colonoscopy in 2 weeks. My Gastroenterologist has had to reschedule me twice or I would already be past this. In December I will be having cataract surgery. They will do my right eye on Dec 8th and my left eye on Dec 22nd. My Ophthalmologist assures me that once I have recovered I will no longer need to wear eye glasses. That just may make it all worthwhile!
